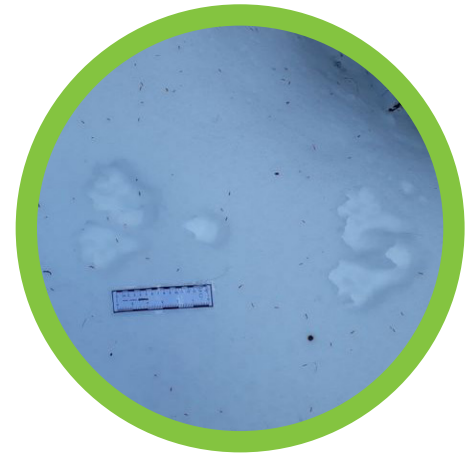


Become a Winter Wildlife Detective!



Take a snow day! Look for fresh snow, where tracks will be easier to identify.

Know what's out and about! Find out what critters are in your area, and then it'll be easier to narrow down possible suspects.

Look around you! Make a note of any field observations that may help in identifying the tracks. This could be weather conditions or natural features the tracks are found near, like a wetland or open field.

Flex those photography skills! Try to take as high-quality images and make sure they're in focus. Take a few different pictures to see the tracks, the gait, and the pattern of movement.

Scale is important! Try to take one picture of the track with an item that will show size. You can use your hand or common objects, like sunglasses or a ruler, if you have one handy.

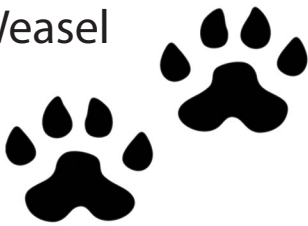
